



RESCUE COST

Winter 2017/2018 – summer 2018 – autumn 2018

Municipal Decree relative to safety in the ski area 11 december 2009 – Rates fixed by board of directors on 9 October 2017 – Applicable tariffs from 1st December 2017.

Rescue operations and searches carried out by the Ski Patrol in Tignes ski area, including transports by ambulance or helicopter, are not free.

IT IS STRONGLY ADVISED TO TAKE OUT AN INSURANCE POLICY (A FRENCH ONE), WHICH WILL COVER THESE COSTS IN CASE OF A SKI ACCIDENT.

RESCUE COST - PATROLLERS

1 st category *	Snowfield zones of the resort First aid Accompanying	54 euros
2 nd category **	Neighbouring areas	212 euros
3 rd category ***	Remote areas	372 euros
4 th category ****	Off piste areas <i>This rate may be increased by the following hourly rates in force:</i> - snowcat - skidoo - patroller	744 euros 200 €/hour 73 €/hour 49 €/hour

* 1st category:

- Rescue (first aid, preparation and evacuation) on snowfield zones of the resort.
- First aid (dressings) without preparation, evacuation or accompanying in neighbouring, remote areas and off pistes.
- Accompanying lightly injured parties on foot or by ski lift, once the rescue service has been called out.
- Transporting lightly injured parties by snow scooter or snowcat over very short distance.

** 2nd category:

- Rescue (first aid, preparation and evacuation) on marked pistes in neighbouring areas, including following pistes for beginners ONLY: Lavachet, Dignes, Rosset, Boïu, Bec rouge, Gliss Park, piste du Centre, Cafo, Pitots, jardins d'enfants, Bollin, Buis et itinéraires de fond.
- Preparation of and assisting in the medical treatment of injured parties being evacuated by helicopter from neighbouring areas, with a view to an emergency evacuation, subject to resources deployed. In this case, the cost of the helicopter will be invoiced additionally (fixed piste rate or by the minute rate).

*** 3rd category:

- Rescue (first aid, preparation and evacuation) on marked pistes in remote areas.
- Preparation of and assisting in the medical treatment of injured parties being evacuated by helicopter from remote areas, with a view to an emergency evacuation, subject to resources deployed. In this case, the cost of the helicopter will be invoiced additionally (fixed rate or by minute rate).

**** 4th category:

→ OFF PISTE AREAS ACCESSIBLE GRAVITATIONALLY BY SKI LIFT:

- Searches, first aid, preparation and evacuation of injured parties out of marked pistes (off piste areas).
- Rescue operations carried out by the piste rescue service in off piste areas when the deployment of a helicopter would have been justified. In this case, the cost of the helicopter will be invoiced additionally (fixed off piste rate or by the minute rate if medical helicopter). This rate may be increased by the hourly rate in force, depending on the human resources and equipment used (snowcats, skidoos, patrollers...).

→ OFF PISTE AREAS NOT ACCESSIBLE GRAVITATIONALLY BY SKI LIFT:

The cost of off-piste rescues from remote areas, rescue caravans and night searches will be invoiced by the hour.

FIRST TRANSPORTS BY AMBULANCE, from bottom of pist to medical center

Private ambulance	from Tignes-le-Lac or Tignes-Val-Claret to medical center	175 euros
Private ambulance	from Brévières or La Daille to medical center	206 euros
Public ambulance	Only if private ambulance is not available	200 euros

Moûtiers hospital	546 euros
Albertville hospital	619 euros
Chambéry or Annecy hospital	941 euros
Grenoble hospital	997 euros
